## Checklist for Digital Day – 8th November:

- Download all the available assets from the <u>Digital Day resources hub:</u>
- Check if you have received the student challenge sheets please allow one sheet per group
- Check if you have received the online BIMA Digital Day Student Questionnaire. <u>It is mandatory that these are completed on the day.</u>
- Check if you have the agency's contact details
- Download the Digital Day certificate please photocopy for number of students
