BIMA plays a crucial role in tackling the digital skills gap in the UK. We approach this challenge by focusing on two main aspects: attracting talent and ensuring that individuals have the necessary skills necessary for success.

ATTRACTING TALENT



It all begins with Digital Day every November, where BIMA members return to school for a day to inspire 10,000 students to consider a career in digital.

Starting January 2024, we are expanding our impact by introducing Digital Day Parents Evenings in the same schools, aimed at educating parents about our industry.

In 2023, our successful BIMA Internship Programme provided opportunities for 4 interns to work at 4 BIMA Member agencies in the South. For 2024, we plan to extend these programmes to other regions.

Since its launch in 2022, the BIMA Bridge council has been diligently working to connect BIMA members interested in supporting or creating opportunities in UK Digital for individuals arriving in the UK as refugees, asylum seekers, and migrants.

LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT



Develop your existing team with company wide access to our skills based training and support.

In 2023, we partnered with Impact Futures, the UK's fastest growing training provider, to help BIMA Members invest in and grow their leadership teams. Through the BIMA Leadership & Management Academy, BIMA Members can access fully government-funded training to upskill their staff.

We also have one of the most respected Mentoring programmes in the industry, and we run regular monthly masterclasses and 6 peer groups meetings to discuss topics such as Strategy, HR, New Business, Marketing and more.



Promoting a diverse, inclusive, and responsible digital community in the UK.

We're at the point of driving huge change in the world, and we have a responsibility to make sure the change is for good and for everyone.

With a firm belief that technology and innovation can save the planet we're still heavily focussed on sustainability.

In 2023, our Sustainability Council launched the world's first set of open guidelines for developing low-carbon websites; and the council also worked to support the creation of the 'Marketing Declares a Climate Emergency' movement to call on the marketing industry to take collective action to limit harm, create change, and rejuvenate our planet, for the sake of our families and our future generations. We also have the amazing Greenpages which is a rich portal of information.

BIMA members also have free access to our Net Zero course every quarter, to lower their carbon footprint.

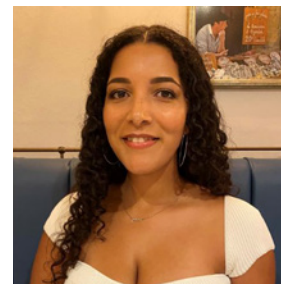

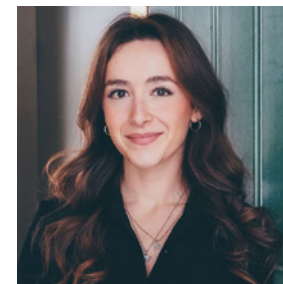
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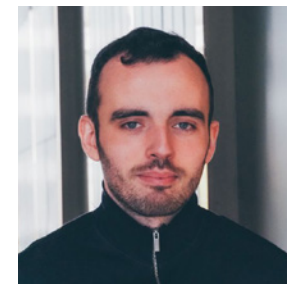
